WINEMAKER NOTES

Our 2019 Pinot Noir is light purple in color and is bursting with aroma and flavor, leading with ripe red cherry, strawberry cream, and raspberry notes. The wine is silky on the palate with red fruit and vanilla undertones, culminating in a clean, lasting finish.

HARVEST & PRODUCTION NOTES

The majority of our 2019 Pinot Noir came from estate vineyards in Lodi, Ca with the balance cultivated in our River Junction appellation.

We harvested between August 2nd and September 10th with an average Brix of 25.2. After 6-9 days of fermentation on the skins, the must was pressed and the resulting wine was finished fermentation in stainless steel tanks. The wine was then aged on new and used French Oak for 6 months.

BLEND

Our blend is predominantly Pinot Noir with a small amount of Petit Verdot and Teroldego added in for texture & color.
